



## FAITH CORE VALUES

### 1. We Believe in the Authority of God and His Word.

- The Bible is the inspired, authoritative Word of God and the final standard for truth, morality, and human conduct. ([2 Timothy 3:16-17](#))
- A biblical worldview provides the foundation for understanding human rights, dignity, justice, and moral order under God. ([Colossians 1:16-17](#))
- Nations flourish when they acknowledge God's authority and uphold principles consistent with His truth. ([Proverbs 14:34](#))



### 2. We Believe in the Sanctity and Protection of Human Life.

- Every human being bears God's image and possesses inherent value from conception to natural death. ([Psalm 139:13-16](#))
- Reproductive technologies, including In vitro fertilization (IVF), must respect the dignity of human life and avoid practices that destroy or commodify embryos. ([Jeremiah 1:5](#))
- Birth control methods should be approached with discernment when they may involve the destruction or disregard of human life. ([Exodus 20:13](#))

### 3. We Believe in God's Design for Marriage, Sexuality, and Identity.

- Marriage is a lifelong covenant between one man and one woman established by God. ([Matthew 19:4-6](#))
- Sexual intimacy is reserved exclusively for the covenant of marriage. ([Hebrews 13:4](#))
- Human identity as male and female is established by God and not subject to personal redefinition. ([Genesis 1:27](#))

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## 4. We Believe in Biblical Manhood, Womanhood, and the Family.

- Men and women are equal in dignity but uniquely designed with complementary roles. ([Genesis 2:18-22](#))
- Fathers play a vital role in the spiritual, moral, and emotional formation of children. ([Malachi 4:6](#))
- Scripture affirms the dignity, strength, and influence of biblical femininity and the role of women within God's design for family and society. ([Proverbs 31:25-31](#))



## 5. We Believe in the Role of Parents and the Formation of Children.

- Parents hold primary responsibility for the upbringing, education, and care of their children. ([Deuteronomy 6:6-7](#))
- Children must be safeguarded from content, ideologies, and systems that exploit or harm their development. ([Matthew 18:6](#))
- Parents are responsible as spiritual authorities for instructing children in truth and guiding their moral development. ([Proverbs 22:6](#))

## 6. We Believe in Personal Responsibility and Moral Integrity.

- Individuals are called to live lives marked by purity and obedience to God's design for sexuality, and to exercise discipline and responsible stewardship over their bodies, actions, and choices. ([1 Corinthians 6:13, 18-20](#))
- Pornography distorts human dignity and undermines healthy relationships and families. ([Matthew 5:27-28](#))
- The misuse of drugs and intoxicating substances harms individuals and contradicts the call to self-control. ([Romans 12:1](#))

## 7. We Believe in Justice, Biblical Equality, and Opposition to False Ideologies.

- All people are equal in dignity and value as image-bearers of God. ([Genesis 1:26](#))
- Biblical justice rejects partiality and favoritism, calling us to judge rightly without elevating or diminishing people based on race, status, or group identity. ([Leviticus 19:15](#))
- Human identity is rooted in God, not in grievance, victimhood, or ideological classification. ([Galatians 3:28](#))

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## 8. We Believe in God-Ordained Institutions and Ordered Society.

- God established His Spheres of Sovereignty—family, church, and civil government—with distinct roles and responsibilities. ([Romans 13:1-4](#))
- Government exists to uphold justice, protect rights, and maintain order. ([Deuteronomy 16:18–20](#))
- Individuals have a legitimate right to defend their lives, families, and communities, including but not limited to, the right to bear arms. ([Luke 22:36](#))

## 9. We Believe in National Sovereignty and Ordered Liberty.

- As God is the creator of borders, nations have a God-ordained responsibility to maintain defined boundaries and govern themselves responsibly in an exercise of national sovereignty. ([Acts 17:26](#))
- Immigration systems should be administered with both justice and compassion under the rule of law. ([Leviticus 24:22](#))
- Centralized global power structures, promises of one-world government and collectivist ideologies undermine accountability, distort the concept of biblical community, and erode national sovereignty. ([Deuteronomy 32:8](#))

## 10. We Believe in the Role of the Church in Society and Civic Engagement.

- Christians are called to be active as salt and light within society. ([Matthew 5:13–16](#))
- Church leaders should be equipped to teach truth and guide believers in cultural and civic engagement. ([2 Timothy 4:2–3](#))
- Christians are called to understand and exercise their civic responsibilities in light of biblical truth. ([Jeremiah 29:7](#))
- Believers are called to live out their faith through active engagement in their communities and institutions. ([James 1:22](#))
