



TEXAS ELECTION CALENDAR 2025-2026

Our constitutional republic depends on active citizen participation. Mark these election dates on your calendar now and commit to voting in every election - from primaries to constitutional amendments to local races. **Primaries are especially crucial** - they determine which candidates appear on the general election ballot, often making them more decisive than the general election itself. Many races are effectively decided in the primary, particularly in safe districts. These off-year and primary elections often have the most direct impact on your daily life, yet they typically see the lowest turnout. Be part of the informed minority that shows up every time. Your community needs your voice in every election, not just the big ones. Make voting a habit, not an exception.

2025 TEXAS ELECTION DATES

November 4, 2025 - Constitutional Amendment Election

- Election Day: November 4, 2025
- Early Voting: October 20-25, 27-31, 2025

2026 TEXAS ELECTION DATES

Primary Elections - March 2026

- Primary Election Day: First Tuesday in March (date TBD by Texas Secretary of State)
- Primary Runoff (if needed): TBD

May 2, 2026 - Local Political Subdivisions Elections

- Election Day: May 2, 2026
- Early Voting: April 20-25, April 27-28, 2026

November 3, 2026 - General Election (Gubernatorial)

- Election Day: November 3, 2026
- Early Voting: October 19-30, 2026
